Abelia x '00-bc-47-13r' PPAF

The golden foliage glows from April into October. In July and August, large, white flower clusters appear at the ends of arching branches. The flowers' sepals turn a blush-tan and remain on the shrub into the fall. Easy to grow.

Abelia x grandiflora 'Hopleys'

New foliage is variegated, golden-yellow with green centers, which matures to ivory and green. Lavender-pink flowers bloom in profusion from summer through fall. Has a low-growing, mounding habit that makes this semi-evergreen a good choice.

Create a graceful, cascading mound of large, heart-shaped, blue-gray to dark, blue-green leaves. The pale-lavender to nearly white flowers arise on a 4-foot scape in midsummer. One of the largest blue-leaved hostas, it grows 3’ high and 4’ wide.

‘GUACAMOLE’ HOSTA

Hosta x ‘Guacamole’

The large, new, avocado-green leaves take on a golden hue in summer, while the margins stay dark-green. The giant, fragrant, pale-lavender flowers appear in late summer. It makes a 3’ wide specimen in your partially shaded hummingbird garden.

'STAINED GLASS' HOSTA

Hosta x 'Stained Glass' PP

Huge, brilliant-gold leaves with wide, dark-green margins, along with prominent veins, puckered foliage and watercolor-like patterning give a "stained glass" look to the shiny leaves. Large, fragrant, pale-lavender flowers appear in late summer.

'WHIRLWIND' HOSTA

Hosta x 'Whirlwind'

Unique leaves with dark-green margins, creamy-white centers inlaid with lime-green veins. The center portions of the leaves will shift to a light green, depending on the amount of sunlight throughout the season.

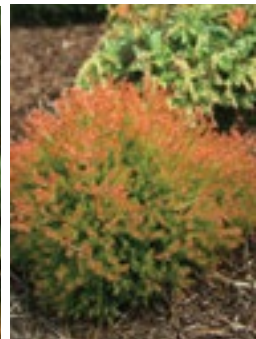

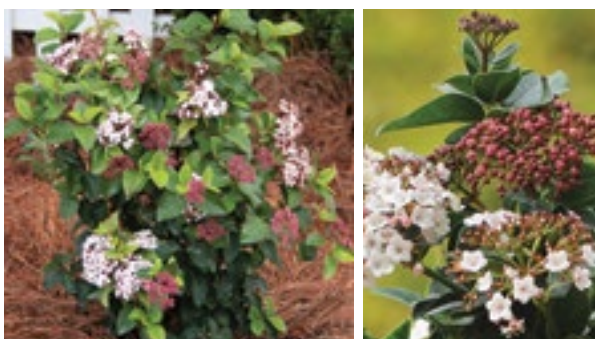

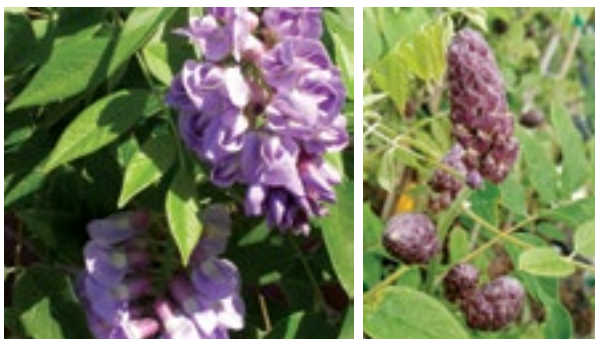
